## **General Rules of Conduct**

The Advanced Training 5 committee and the Sacramento Betsuin will do whatever they can to help make this experience as pleasant and memorable as possible. The following general rules have been created for the safety and consideration of all of the program participants. **Individuals who disregard the rules will be sent home immediately.**

1. Please be mindful of the Three Treasures at all times in your conduct, actions, thoughts and words.
2. Please be considerate of your fellow participants at all times.
3. Please meet at the arranged meeting places at the designated times.
4. Alcohol or smoking will not be allowed on the temple grounds.
5. Program participants may **NOT** leave the temple premises at any time without consent of the program coordinators or supervising adult(s).
6. Telephone use is limited to phone cards or collect calls during recreation and free time only. Personal calls should not be made using the temple phone number, except in the case of emergencies.
7. Personal telephones and pagers **MUST** be turned **OFF** during lectures and seminars.
8. Please observe and respect the time limits allocated for showers and facilities.
9. Please help keep the temple facilities clean by checking your surroundings, throwing away any leftover trash, and leaving the area neat and orderly.
10. As a courtesy to the ministers, staff and to the other participants, please be on time for all sessions and activities.
11. Please abide by the 'lights-out' request each night out of consideration for others participating in the program.
12. For your safety, participants are to remain in their assigned rooms after 'lights-out', with the exception of using the restroom facilities.
